location near the towns of Vrsar, Poreč and Rovinj.

Sveti Lovreč is located on the western part of the Istrian peninsula. This hidden gem is one of the best preserved medieval fortified towns in Istria. The settlement got its name from the church of St. Lovre, which dates back to the 8th century, while the Romanesque bell tower was added to it in the 11th century, and is located in the local cemetery not far from the village.

The circular shape of the settlement dates back to prehistoric times, when there was a castle on the same hill. Already in the Byzantine era, Lovreč was fortified with ramparts and towers, which were later thoroughly renovated on several occasions, and most of the fortifications visible today originate from the Venetian era, when Sveti Lovreč was the headquarters of the military administration of the entire Venetian part of Istria.

The surroundings of St. Lovreč are surrounded by numerous smaller villages where numerous beautiful villas have sprung up. It is important to note that Sveti Lovreč is becoming a sought-after tourist destination and an extremely sought-after destination for construction and living.
